Athletes **MUST** respect their fellow athletes, competitors and coaches.

Athletes must listen to the coaches, and do as they are told. An athlete who repeatedly refuses to do this will be asked to leave the training session. Parent/Guardian will be informed if behaviour persists.

Athletes who are unable to take part in training due to injury or illness, should **NOT** attend training.

The use of mobile phones is **NOT** permitted during training.

Children are not allowed opt out of part of the session. Part of the training is to learn to keep trying.

We operate a card system at Bandon AC, when kids are misbehaving.

First offence yellow, second offence yellow and third offence red card and parents shall be notified

Bandon Athletic Club Code of Conduct for Children and Young Athletes

Sport should be safe, fun and conducted in a spirit of fair play As a child or young person you entitled to the best possible environment to participate in sport. You deserve to be given enjoyable, safe sporting opportunities, free of abuse of any kind. You have rights, which must be respected, and responsibilities that you must accept. You are encouraged to treat other athletes and team officials with fairness and respect.

You are entitled to:

- Be safe and to feel safe/Be listened to/Be believed.
- Be treated with dignity, sensitivity, and respect.
- Have a voice in your club/Participate on an equal basis/Have fun and enjoy sport
- Experience competition at a level at which you feel comfortable
- Make complaints and have them dealt with
- Get help against bullies/Say no/To protect your body/Confidentiality

You should always:

- Treat Sports Leaders with respect
- Act fairly at all times, do your best
- Respect other club members
- Respect opponents and be gracious in defeat
- Abide by the rules

You should never:

- Cheat
- Use violence or physical contact that is not allowed within the rules
- Shout or argue/Cause harm or damage property/Bully
- Take banned substances/Tell lies/Spread rumours

3. If kids meet competition standards in their age group and are ready themselves and happy to compete, they will be selected to partake in upcoming competitions by their coach(s). Some children even though they may have reached the standard to compete, are not comfortable doing so and prefer not to compete.

4. Where there is no bus traveling to a competition, it is the responsibility of the parent/Guardian to get the child to that competition. For U9's & U10's a parent/guardian must stay with child.

5. The club colours are yellow singlet/black shorts. Own singlet is required for competitions & must be worn at all competitions.
