

Track Cost Overview

The estimated full cost of developing the track, associated field activities & walking/jogging track is expected to be in the region of €1.25 million.

This is made up of:

- 1. Site Purchase & Assoicated
- 2. Entrance & Fencing
- 3. Groundworks
- 4. Lighting
- 5. Field Event Construction
- 6. Tarmac
- 7. Tartan & Lining
- 8. Equipment
- Cross Country/WalkingTrack

The funding is in place for the first 6 elements of the project above thanks to:

- ✓ Significant State and Local
 County Council Funding
- ✓ Generous Sponsorship of Local Businesses
- ✓ Loan for Site Purchase
- Club Fundraising supported by club members and local community

There is still a Shortfall of over €500K to complete the last four elements above. We hope to get some further state funding via the latest Sports
Capital Fund but need to provide significant funding ourselves to complete. The Lotto will be an important source of such vital funds so your support is very much appreciated!!



The lotto depends on the support of club members & other stakeholders within the community. The main function of the lotto is to help finance our new track.

We really need your help now!!

Our aim is to consolidate all fundraising aimed at club members into the Lotto going forward so we don't keep looking for your support in different forms.

We would love if every family associated with the athletic club could help by:

1.Signing up to an annual subscription supporting the lottery at cost of only €2 per week; (Preference is an annual or bi-annual subscription to minimize transaction charges)

2.Sourcing at least one other subscriber to support the lottery for the full year.

This funding will facilitate the construction & maintenance of a topclass, local facility for the benefit of our members & the local community.

We can't do this without your assistance.

The following explains the financial aspect of our funding model.

Income:

- Our steady source of income comes from a portion of the annual subscriptions and the €2 received on training nights.
- The club receives financial support through grants, sponsorship, fundraising and donations towards the capital costs of the athletic track.

Expenditure:

- Bandon AC pays a large portion of the annual subscriptions to Athletics Ireland to register every club member;
- The club also pays entry fees for all competitions;
- The club has a long termrental agreement with BGS and the costs incurred are fixed, regardless of the number of athletes attending;
- The club must also purchase new equipment and replace old equipment every year;
- Loan repayments are required to cover the cost of loans for site purchase plus any other loads required;

Grants

Sports Capital Grant



Bandon AC were thrilled to receive a fantastic €290,000 from the <u>2020 Sports Capital</u> <u>Grant</u> Scheme in 2021.

This grant has been used for the extensive groundworks required to level and layout the site for the track, as well as the significant lighting requirements.

The club are hugely grateful to the local TDs, Senators and Councillors for their terrific public support of this project and for bringing it to Government attention on the Dail floor.

The club has recently applied for the 2023 Sports Capital Grant for assistance with completing the final phases and are very hopeful of further assistance to bring the project to completion.

Cork County Council Grants



Cork County Council provided a generous grant of €20,000 in 2021 towards the cost of the entrance & erection of the boundary fencing under the Community Fund Scheme.

A further €50,000 grant was received in 2023 from the **Community Recognition Fund** which is being used for kerbing the track & foundational work on the field events.

We are hugely thankful to Cork County Council and our very supportive local councillors for giving us such a fantastic head start on this project.

Access Credit Union

The club were delighted to receive €2000 from Access Credit Union Community Fund.
